Call for papers

Submission Guidelines

- At least one author of each accepted paper must complete registration and payment by October 27, 2026.
- The final camera-ready version must address the reviewers' comments and comply with IEEE formatting and publication requirements.
- The paper must be presented during IEEE ENC 2026 on November 11, 2026, to remain eligible for submission to IEEE Xplore.

Publication

Accepted papers must be presented orally at the workshop. Once accepted and revised according to reviewer recommendations, they will be submitted to IEEE Xplore for inclusion, subject to compliance with IEEE's quality and publication requirements. ISBN: 979-8-3195-2541-3. Online ISSN: 2332-5712.
